

POLICY TITLE	Removal of Radio Subscriber Safety Features
POLICY NUMBER	2016-01
FUNCTION	Operations and Communications Systems
APPLIES TO	All Subscribers and Users of the CC911 Communications System

I. SCOPE / PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to set forth the guidelines for removal of safety features from equipment associated and affiliated with the CC911 Communications System.

II. BACKGROUND

CC911 is an emergency communications district pursuant to the Code of Alabama 1975 Section 11-98-4. As a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP), CC911's Communications Center receives, processes, and disseminates every 9-1-1 call in Calhoun County, Alabama. As an additional responsibility, CC911 also maintains and operates a regional 700/800 MHz radio communications system which provides, among other benefits, advance safety features to locate and communicate with users and subscribers of the System. The two-way, land-mobile radio (LMR) radio communications, which enables certain voice and data capabilities for subscribers, is the primary means by which authorities coordinate their response to public safety incidents and emergencies.

III. POLICY, PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

ANY Subscriber, User or other affiliate to the CC911 Radio Communications System shall maintain, at all times, all pre-installed safety features of the communication equipment. Should any Subscriber, User or other affiliate desire to remove or disable such safety features, such removal or disabling shall only be attempted or accomplished by CC911. Prior to such removal or disabling, such Subscriber, User or other affiliate shall execute a fully binding release, hold-harmless and full indemnification agreement in such form as prescribed by CC911. Such decision and agreement execution shall be withheld to the highest level of decision making authority for said Subscriber, User or other affiliate.
